COMPETITION ENTRY INFORMATION

Entry fee

\$79.86 + GST per player

Team Nomination

Entries will be submitted via MyNetball, as instructed. Instructions on how to nominate teams in MyNetball will be provided.

Player registration

Following the close of entries, players entered will be sent a link to register themselves to a team in the Fast5 Game Management System. Full instructions and support will be provided.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

- Associations may enter a maximum of (4) teams in the 2018 Fast5 Summer series
- An Association is permitted to have one team only in each Division
- A maximum of 6 teams will be graded in each Division.
- Associations shall register teams on MyNetball as instructed, and will be required to submit the team nomination grading report together with the team entry form.
- A minimum of five (5) and maximum of ten (10) players' names and their relevant playing status, will be submitted by the advertised closing date.
- The minimum age for any player to play in the Fast5 Summer Series Competition is turning 15 in the year of play.
- Grading for the 2018 Fast5 Summer Series Competition shall be based on names submitted on the official entry forms and taking into account a player's highest level played in the same year across competitions such as:
 - o Premier League;
 - o Metro League;
 - o State Championships;
 - o State Age Championships; and
 - o Night Interdistrict.
- All grading of teams will be made at the discretion of Netball NSW.

UMPIRES

Each Association is to provide a National Badged umpire for each team entered. An information session will be held closer to the commencement of the Competition for umpires interested.

SCORERS

Each Association is to provide one (1) scorer per match. Games will be centrally timed.
