Bush Fire Hazard Reduction Notification

Please be advised that hazard reduction works are proposed in the vicinity of your suburb. This will consist of burning surface vegetation to reduce bush fire fuel.

The hazard reduction burn will be conducted in the Liverpool Military Area and is 800 hectares in size. It will be conducted over a number of days.

The activity aims to reduce fuel which lessens the intensity and spread of fire, potentially reducing the impact that a fire may have to your property.

The burn will be coordinated by the NSW Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) and implementation is subject to fuel and weather conditions on the day. The bulk of burning activity is scheduled for:

Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th April 2018

The activity will generate smoke, hot embers and heat. It is important that you take the following action either prior to, during and for days after the activity.

- Keep doors and windows closed to prevent smoke entering homes;
- Keep outdoor furniture under cover to prevent ember burns;
- Retract pool covers to prevent ember damage;
- Remove washing from clotheslines;
- Ensure pets have a protected area;
- If you are driving a vehicle, slow down, keep windows up and turn headlights on; and
- If you have asthma or a lung condition, reduce outdoor activities. If smoke levels are high and if shortness of breath or coughing develops, take your reliever medicine or seek medical advice.

Should the burn not take place due to conditions not being favourable, then a contingency date has been identified for the following weekend (21-22 April 2018).

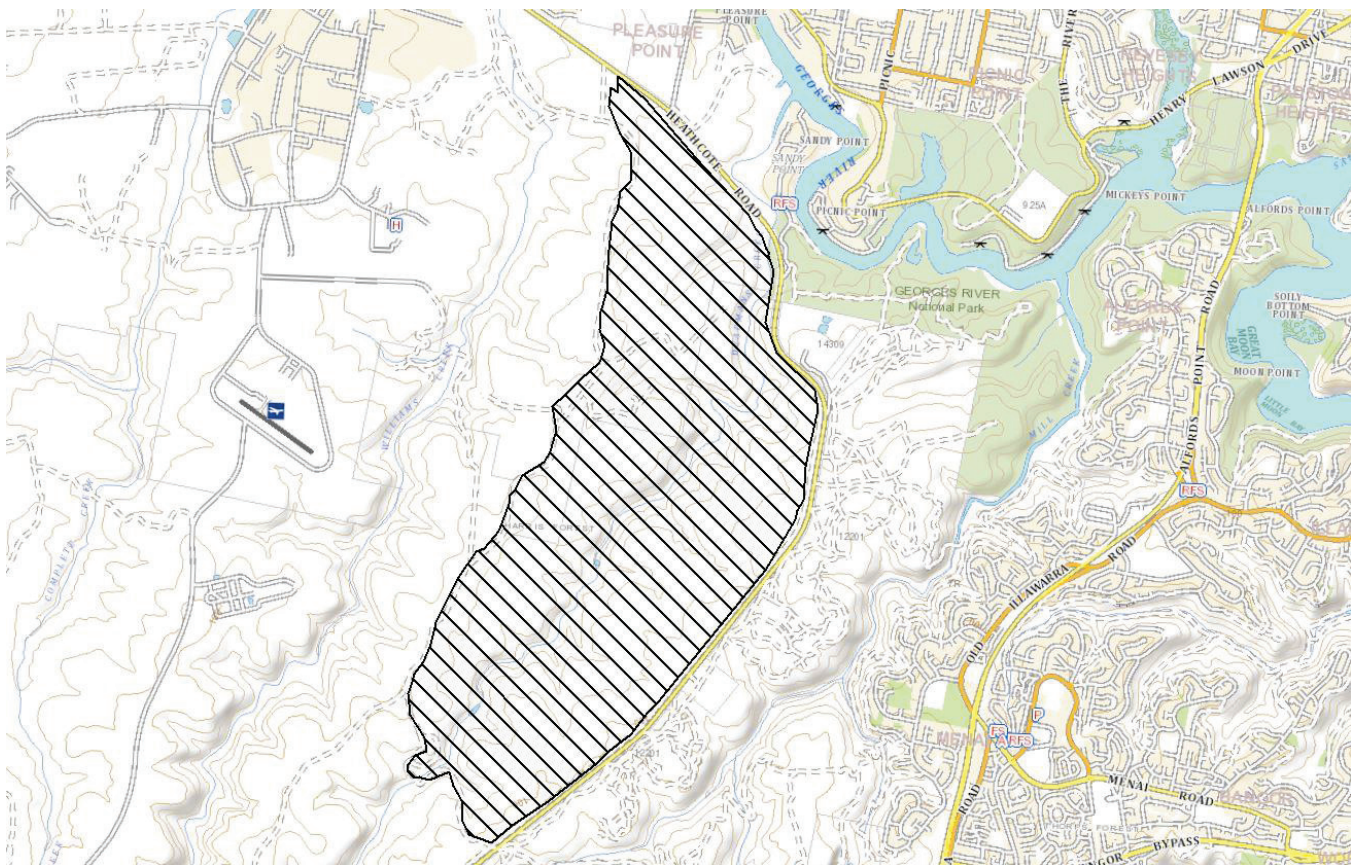
Information relating to the burn will be available via social media, the NSW RFS website and portable variable messaging signs in the area. This notice is valid until 22 April 2018.
