

Sutherland Shire Netball Association – Days 8 & 9 Information

8's and 9's years

8's & 9's will not play finals. They will continue to play round games. Location, times & courts as per in MyNetball. Days 8 & 9 playing times will be the same time for each day (no rotation)

Day 8 - 5th Sep - will be played at Seymour Shaw

Day 9 - 12th Sep - will be played at Barden Ridge, this will be the final day of play.

Clubs to supply own umpires for these games

Venues & Dates for Ages 10 up

10 years (except for 10A) & 11C1/10C1 Grades

Day 8 - 5th Sep - played at Seymour Shaw

Day 9 - 12th Sep - played at Barden Ridge

Grade B3, C2, C4, C6, D1 & D2

Day 8 - 5th Sep – played at Barden Ridge

Day 9 - 12th Sep – Played at Barden Ridge

In the event of Wet Weather on Day 9 (12th September) – games will be played on 19th September at The Ridge

All other junior and senior grades who currently play at Bellingara will remain there

Day 8 - 5th Sep – played at Bellingara

12th September – No play due to Chemical Clean up

Day 9 - 19th Sep – Played at Bellingara

Competition Rules

Day 8 Draw – 1V4, 2V3, 5V8, 6V7

In the event of a draw the team that placed higher at the end of Day 7 on the competition ladder will be deemed the winner of the game. Higher placed teams will be highlighted (so there is no confusion). There will be no extra time played due to current Covid restrictions.

Day 9 Draw

Winner 1 v 4 versus Winner 2 v 3 – this is the Grand Final

All other teams will play off for their final spot on the ladder

Loser of 1 V 4 versus Loser of 2 V 3 – 3rd and 4th places

Winner of 5 V 8 versus Winner of 6 V 7 – 5th and 6th places

Loser of 5 V 8 versus Loser of 6 V 7 – 7th and 8th places

In the event of a Draw the teams will be Joint Winners - Premiers for the Grand Final games (due to Covid and time restrictions) and be awarded equal places from 3 to 8.

Playing Times

Days 8 & 9 playing times will be the same time for each day (no rotation)

Umpires

Teams 1 to 4 – Will be allocated by SSNA.

Team to pay umpires on the day - \$20 for morning games & \$30 for afternoon games.

This is the rate agreed upon by club delegates at the Council meeting.

Clubs must nominate umpire who would like to be considered to umpire 1 to 4. This must be emailed to Di Maclachlan by Saturday 29th August. All umpire Convenors have been advised of this.

Teams 5 to 8 – Umpire their own

Clubs/umpires convenors to allocate and pay as per current process that was followed during Days 1 to 7.

2020 Days 8 & 9 Competition Rules

To qualify to play

Teams 1 to 4

- All players taking the court must be registered players of that team (i.e., played at least 3 games over the past 7 days of play, and, if they have played up from another team must have also played 3 games to qualify). Playing $\frac{1}{4}$ of a game is counted as 1 game.
- No borrowing of players from other teams for teams placed 1 to 4

Teams 5 to 8

- All players taking the court must be registered players of that club. Second game rules to apply if teams need to borrow players. No individual player is to play 3 games.

Important Further information

Please note: could teams that are not intending to play Days 8 & 9 please indicate as soon as possible as a re – allocation of games will need to be determined. For Grades that only have 6 teams in the grade information regarding Day 9 will be confirmed on Saturday 29th August (Day 8 – 5 vs 6 will play) and for grades that have 7 teams information regarding Days 8 & 9 will be confirmed on Monday 31st August.
